Homework

In Year 1, homework will be given online on a weekly basis via Google Classroom (beginning on Week 2 - Monday 11th of September).

Homework plays a vital role in helping children consolidate what they have learnt in class and it is really important that all children complete their homework each week independently.

Reading

Children should take part in a reading activity every night.

Reading will help your child develop in all areas of the curriculum and your support at home can have the greatest impact on your child's overall achievement.

Maths

Children should spend at least 40 minutes a week on IXL. for reading and maths.

Spelling

During this term, we will be revising letter sounds and learning Year 1 Spelling words. .

Children will be tested on 6 words each week (on Thursday).
