Minutes of the Rights-Respecting (R-R) Steering Group – 13:00 15th April 2016

1. School STOMP assembly

- a. Discussed the focus of STOMP – young people who are sick but have no access to medical care or help.
- b. We are global citizens and have the responsibility to try to change that for others.
- c. Discussed that we are working with STOMP because it fits in with our charter.
- d. We looked at which articles from the convention the people from STOMP assembly do not have access to:
 - 24 and 27
- e. FM reminded the group that it was their responsibility to remind their classmates about why we are doing the school STOMP next Thursday, that we are raising money to support those without access to all their rights.

2. Playground games

- a. FM gave out laminated cards of international playground games. Pairs went through the cards and fed back on the games – i.e. how easy it would be to explain them to the rest of the school and play them in our playground.
- b. Lots of the games seem quite confusing at first so we could use the ‘make it easier’ tips on the back of each card.
- c. It was decided that we would look at 3 games per half term and make sure the ambassadors know them well so they can teach them to the other children. Ernest suggested we choose different games depending on the seasons.
