I am writing to inform you of a vacancy for the role of parent governor on our governing body.

Our school's governing body is responsible for providing confident and strategic leadership, and creating robust accountability, oversight and assurance for our school's educational and financial performance.

- Good interpersonal skills, curiosity, and a willingness to learn and develop new skills
- The specific skills required to make sure the governing body delivers effective governance

Governors are expected to adhere to the <u>seven principles which should be applied in public</u> <u>life</u>, of selflessness, integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness, honesty and leadership.

Furthermore we would expect governors to:

- Attend meetings regularly
- Act, and be seen to act, impartially
- Maintain confidentiality
- Attend regular training
- Commit to the 4 year term of office

We are keen to invite candidates who have skills in the areas of law, finance and fundraising.

If we receive more applications than there are vacancies, a confidential ballot will be carried out. We will inform you closer to the time if we have to do this.
