What is the Sports Premium?

The Department for Education (DfE) spent over £450 million on improving physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools over the last 4 academic years.

The Premium must be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of primary aged pupils within and beyond the school day to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

Strategic overview of PPSG (Primary PE Sports Funding) spending:

- To further improve the PE provision at Burdett-Coutts.
- To broaden the sporting opportunities available to our pupils, through in school lessons and as those offered as Enrichment Club Activities.
- To include as many pupils as possible into competitive sport through entering a wide range of competitions at all age ranges.
- To continue to develop a love of sport and physical activity, including the benefit that sport can have on supporting positive mental health.
- To develop a range of activities and lessons to support the learning and understanding of nutrition on our bodies and minds.

Our school allocation for 2023/2024

Our school has been awarded £17,000 for the academic year 2023/2024 and we intend to use the funding as outlined below.

Swimming lessons for Years 3 - 6. These will run as a block of 2 hour lessons over an 8 day block (2 blocks of 4 days).	£4000	Opportunity to gain confidence, increase fitness levels and give lifelong swimming and learning skills.	
Funding the hiring of qualified sports coaches to teach sport in in School and for After School Clubs	£8,500	This will ensure the children have access to high quality teaching in their after school clubs to ensure high standards for provision.	
Broadening the range of specialist sports offered as part of our Enrichment Club offer, including the inclusion of a running club in the summer term again.	£3,000	In partnership with other local primary schools.	
High quality sports equipment to further support the PE provision	£1000	Children will have the appropriate equipment to ensure that they can participate fully in PE activities.	
Promote an active lifestyle and support the learning and understanding of nutrition on our bodies and minds.	£500	Plan and administer sessions and workshops in eating and healthy living for families in order to have a better understanding of an active and healthy lifestyle
